

**PILESGROVE TOWNSHIP
APRIL 8, 2008
WORK SESSION MEETING
MINUTES**

Resident Cheryl Reardon inquired if a settlement had been reached in the Cotler/Pierson v Pilesgrove litigation. Mayor Bickford advised no, but the property owners are pursuing farmland preservation on the property.
