PILESGROVE TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 23-017 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PILESGROVE TOWNSHIP CODE CHAPTER 150 "SOLID WASTE"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Pilesgrove that the following amendments be made to Chapter 150, Solid Waste, of the Code of the Township of Pilesgrove:

Section 150-3 Illegal Dumping shall be amended as follows:

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to discard or dump along any street or road, on or off any right-of-way, any household or commercial solid waste, rubbish, refuse, junk, vehicle or vehicle parts, rubber tires, appliances, furniture or private property, except by written consent of the owner of said property, in any place not specifically designated for the purpose of solid waste storage or disposal.

(b). Yard Waste

Sweeping, raking, blowing or otherwise placing yard waste that is not containerized at the curb or along the street is prohibited. Placement of such yard waste at the curb or along the street is a violation of this ordinance. If such placement of yard waste occurs, the party responsible for placement of the yard waste must remove the yard waste from the street or said party shall be deemed in violation of this ordinance.

(c). Enforcement: The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by Pilesgrove Township's Zoning Officer. Violations and penalties are detailed within this section at 150-11.
