

Pilesgrove Township has temporarily closed the Municipal Building to members of the public, effective Tuesday March 17, 2020. This move is in response to Governor Murphy's strong recommendations to all government entities in the state regarding the rapidly evolving Covid-19 Corona virus situation.

For the time being, members of the staff In the Construction, Zoning and Housing Office are continuing to work in the Municipal building and are available to help members of the public via phone, fax and email; 8:30am 4:00pm Monday and 8:30am to 5:00pm on Wednesday.

At this time all documents submitted to the Township must be mailed, faxed or emailed. We also have a drop box on the back of the building. If you received an email or phone call stating your permit has been approved, please mail a check for the balance due or place a check in an envelope in the lock box on the back of the building.

Be sure to include the email address and/or mailing address to where you would like the permits sent. Your permit will be mailed via USPS.

The Construction Official (and Sub Code Official) will continue to be in the Office regular hours with inspections to follow. However, Inspections will be limited to those that do not include direct personal interaction.

This is an unprecedented time for everyone. The situation at the local, state, national and global scale seems to be changing daily. Pilesgrove Township is committed to maintaining our operations to ensure continued service to the public with as little interruption as possible, while instituting safeguards for the good of our employees and the community.
